

This module helps the children to learn to say where they are going on holiday, if they are staying at home, what they are going to do in summer, as well as where they went last year. They will finish this unit by expressing reasons and opinions based on holidays, and asking others questions about their holidays.

Module 12

Module 11 focuses on school. The children will look at school subjects and will learn how to say 12 subjects. They will be able to express opinions on subjects and teachers. They will say where they go to school, how they go to school, how far away school is, how big school is, where they eat lunch and what they wear to school. They will learn verbs and use them in present tense 3rd and 1st person, and use the infinitive verb form too.

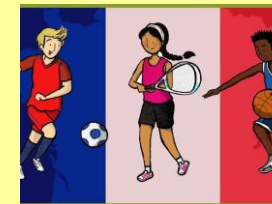
Module 11



The children will recap numbers and will learn new numbers 61-100. They will be using their knowledge of numbers to multiply and divide. The children will look at describing people, including family, and describe their characteristics. They will learn to express opinions on areas like sports they enjoy, hobbies and favourite teams.

To start this module off, the children will recap numbers and work towards looking at numbers 41-60, while adding and taking away in French. Children will learn about clothing, school uniform, and to describe themselves in French.

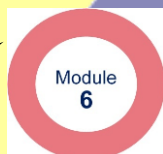
Year 5



Throughout this module, the children will learn to name items in their bedroom and say what they have in their bedroom. They will also look at naming body parts, including features on the face. They will learn to express opinion about food and drink, as well as naming food and drink items. The children will also learn how to ask how much something is as well.



Module 9 will teach the children to name 15 different types of shops, saying what they buy in the shops, and asking how much something is. They will also learn the names of 10 places in town and will be able to give basic directions by the end, including using adjectives to describe places and things.



In this module, the children learn the vocabulary for rooms in their house and saying where they live. They will learn how to write simple sentences and look closely at the locations of capital cities.



Module 3 looks at families and other relationships in French. Children will learn how to introduce their family, saying what brothers/sisters they have and how to say if they do not have brothers/sisters. They will learn to say who they are in 3rd person, how old they are and also what pets they have/haven't got. Finally, they will talk about their belongings.

In this module, the children look closely at what they carry in their school bag as well as items in the classroom. They will look more closely at masculine and feminine forms. They will also discuss their likes and dislikes.

Module 5

This module looks more at everyday things children need to be able to say in French, including 8 masculine objects and 8 feminine objects. The children will also learn the days of the week in French, as well as numbers 13-20 and time to the hour.



In this module, the children begin by looking at the alphabet and spelling words. They then move onto numbers and incorporating this with telling the time. The children then look at their birthday and finish the unit by looking at weather.

MODULE 4

This module encompasses the basic skills a child needs to speak French. It covers typical greetings and goodbyes, saying how I am as well as returning a question back to another person. The children will learn how to say their name, age, location and yes/no. They will also be able to say thank you, as well as learning numbers to 12 and 11 different colours.
