Attendance continues to be a priority for the school and we are working really hard on it. We are doing really well and lots of classes have recently had non-uniform days for 100% attendance during a whole week. We hope that this will continue! We have introduced Attendance Ambassadors this term and they are working really well in each class, raising the profile of how importance attendance in school is.

Currently our whole school figure is 96.2% which is also our DFE Government target- hopefully we'll maintain this until the end of the year! Ford class are currently in the lead with 97.3% closely followed by Picasso and Pankhurst who have 97.2% so we will have to wait to see who are our class champions at the end of the year! We also have a number of classes who are all above 96% which is really positive too!

Just a reminder that we cannot authorise holidays in term time and if the absence is 5 days or above the Local Authority will issue a Penalty Notice. After the 3rd Penalty Notice court proceeding can take place so please be aware of this when booking holidays. Wherever possible, please book holidays in the school holidays or make use of INSET days.
